## TO THE EDITOR OF THE TIMES

Oxford

Sir, – We wish to associate ourselves with the view expressed in your issues of 21 and 25 January by the Master of Clare College and other senior members of Cambridge University on the expulsion from the Federation of Rhodesia and Nyasaland of Dr Terence Ranger.

We wish to urge that Dr Terence Ranger, a former member of St Antony's College, Oxford, be permitted to continue in his post at the University College in Salisbury. Dr Ranger is a man of the highest integrity and a scholar of great ability. His expulsion will

cause him considerable hardship, as well as depriving the University College in Salisbury of an able teacher.

We support his case on these personal grounds as well as in the interest of the fundamental principles of academic freedom and inter-university cooperation in the Commonwealth and the free world.
